NOTICE OF INTENT TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING AND CONSIDER ADOPTION OF PROPOSED IMPACT FEE RESOLUTION AND TO ADOPT, ENACT, OR MODIFY AN IMPACT FEE FACILITIES PLAN AND WRITTEN IMPACT FEE ANALYSIS FOR FIRE AND EMS SERVICES.

The purpose of the public hearing is to hear public comment, and to answer questions about, the proposed impact fee resolution, and to consider approval and adoption of the resolution, impact fee facilities plan, and impact fee analysis, by the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD Control Board. All interested persons are invited to attend the hearing and make comments. All interested persons in attendance at the public hearing shall be given the opportunity to be heard.
